- 3. Use your call sign for user name and create a password.
- 4. Enter in all the information as required, please make sure you include your Home and Cell Phone Numbers and your Email address.
- 5. Go to <a href="https://groups.io">https://groups.io</a> and sign up. Then join the heares-alerts group. This will cause you to receive all alert messages from the ARES/RACES team.
